

Regulation for the participation in the Open Call for testing in the ATLANTIS Test Centre

Article 1

Scope and Objectives

- 1. This regulation document defines the rules and access conditions to the call for testing in the ATLANTIS Test Centre in a near real environment
- **2.** In the Notice of the Open Call, additional and more specific conditions can be defined in the addition the ones presented in this document.

Article 2

Participant Eligibility Criteria

- **1.** The potential candidates are expected to:
 - a. Be an existing company;
 - **b.** Develop or use robotic technologies for/in the area for inspection and maintenance.
- **2.** The above eligibility criteria are required to be met at the time of closing of the submission period.
- **3.** While all companies are welcome to apply, start-ups, small and medium enterprises and Universities will be given priority.

Article 3

Testing Eligibility Criteria

- **1.** The proposed robotic technologies for testing are expected to be directly involved in inspection operations.
- **2.** The proposed testing is expected to:
 - a. Identify a Principal Investigator (PI) or legal responsible.
 - **b.** Relate with one of the four showcases targeted in ATLANTIS, with the relevance of the testing adequately described.
 - c. Provide a clear and detailed methodology.
 - **d.** Clearly identify the required support equipment for the testing.
 - e. Indicate the expected required human resources and duration of the test.
- **3.** Multiple submission from the same entity are accepted however, only the last one will be considered by the jury.





Article 4

Eligible Expenses

The eligible expenses covered by the funding of the call include the following:

- 1. Operation costs.
- 2. Technical support.
- **3.** Lunch for the involved personnel.

Article 5

Non-eligible Expenses

The funding for testing of technologies will not cover:

- **1.** Travel arrangements.
- 2. Accommodation.
- 3. Transport of material.

Article 6

Submission of proposals

- **1.** The submission of testing proposals will be performed through the ATLANTIS project website.
- 2. All proposal should be submitted in English.
- **3.** The dates for the opening and closing of the submission process are presented in the notice of open call.

Article 7

Evaluation panel

- 1. The evaluation of the submitted proposals will be performed by an internal panel of the consortium, nevertheless, the ATLANTIS project may invite external experts in case of ethical conflicts.
- **2.** The evaluation panel will include members of different partners, to ensure the representation of the complete supply chain.
- **3.** It is the responsibility of the evaluation panel to:
 - **a.** Apply the evaluation criteria defined in the notice of open call to assess the submitted proposals;
 - **b.** Rank the proposals and select the ones to accept.





Article 8

Evaluation criteria

- **1.** The submitted proposals are assessed according to the criteria defined and presented in the notice of open call.
- **2.** All proposals are ranked according to the final grade, from highest to lowest, and will be funded until the budget limit defined in the ATLANTIS.

Article 9

Notification of the Selection decision

- 1. The PI of each proposal will be notified of the selection decision.
- **2.** Any question or plea regarding the decision should be presented within 10 working days of the notification.
- **3.** The acceptance of the decision should be formalised in 10 working days upon notification.

Article 10

Insurance

- 1. The ATLANITS consortium is not responsible for damages that take place during the operation of the robotic technologies in the ATLANTIS Test Centre.
- **2.** All equipment used in any testing performed in the ATLANTIS Test Centre is recommended to be insured.

Article 11

Cancelation or Changes in the testing

- **1.** Cancelation and/or alteration of the testing dates can occur due to weather conditions or other factors.
- **2.** The ATLANTIS Consortium is not liable for potential costs related to changes due to force majeure, outside of the consortium control.
- **3.** In the case of alterations in the dates for testing, the ATLANIS will propose alternative dates to ensure the possibility of testing of the selected proposals.
